Re: IA CD3 Poll Findings

Polling conducted by Impact Research of likely 2022 General Election voters in Iowa’s 3rd Congressional District finds that Cindy Axne is tied in the race for Congress. Additionally, this poll finds that voters are reacting to Zach Nunn’s position in favor of banning all abortions without exceptions for rape, incest, or to save the life of the woman.

Rep. Cindy Axne is tied with Zach Nunn in the current vote for Congress in this district Donald Trump carried in 2020.

- The race for Congress in Iowa’s 3rd CD is highly competitive and Axne is tied with Nunn (47% Axne / 47% Nunn / 5% undecided).

Nunn’s extreme abortion stance is a glaring vulnerability already hurting his image, and the Axne campaign and its allies can continue exploiting this and other hits to damage him further.

- Nunn has embraced a national ban on abortion with no exceptions even in cases of rape, incest, or to save a woman’s life. This extreme stance puts him far outside the mainstream on a highly salient issue, and he knows it – he is already lying about his position.
- In an open-ended question, people say that they have heard about Nunn’s harsh positions on abortion (the larger the word is below, the more voters said that word in response when asked, “What have you seen or heard about Zach Nunn in the last few weeks?”):



Impact Research conducted n=500 interviews with likely 2022 General Election voters in Iowa’s 3rd CD from September 7-11, 2022 via landline, cell phone, and text-to-web. Expected margin of sampling error is +/- 4.4% for the full sample at the 95% level of confidence. The margin of error for subgroups varies and is higher.
